The Plan

*Sep 2 - Oct 17:* Let the eclipse energy swirl things around.

Personal: This is time to watch, learn, and listen. Pay attention to the signs. If you feel nervous, wait to take action. We can be getting a lot of information for our personal lives and understanding about to move through the portal of the next six months. Just see what happens and find it fascinating. Take notes like a journalist.

World: Reversals and upsets, ungrounded decision making, and increasing intensity. Occasionally, eclipses can bring about an unexpected reprieve in the violence and discord---but that is unlikely. The instability in the world grows and that likely includes the stock market (which is not the economy).

*Oct 18 - Dec 5:* Get ready for the winter. Take care of business. Do your best. Whatever it takes to get through the wild ride.

Personal: Take the signs that you received during the eclipses and create a plan for the winter. You can get things done right now (if you can turn down the volume on the news). Clean, organize, focus on your purpose, your work, and being there for loved ones. Mars is in its pre-shadow time, foreshadowing a difficult time in the world.

World: The stuff going down right now is real. Unfortunately, we need Pluto to go out of bounds to really make the revolution work—and be able to take down people in power who have abused the power terribly—Putin, Netanyahu,

### ***First 40-Day Practice***

*Dec 5 - Jan 14:* Shiva, Kali, Lilith, Persephone, Demeter, Hades--go into the underworld and stir things up. Bring on the transformation.

Suggestions:

Kundalini Yoga has 40-day kriyas. Dive into one that includes shaking, movement, and/or mantras **xxxxxx**

40-day grief practices

40-days to clean and clear your home or office or garden. Get the energy in your home moving by cleaning out stuck places like the back of the frig, or a closet you avoid.

5 minutes of “Om Namah Shivaya” a day.

Headstands, cobras, and camels.

### *Second 40-Day Practice*

*Jan 15 - Feb 24:* Practice stillness. During this time, even though the days are short and it is cold in the Northern Hemisphere, we may be easily pulled into the world. Do your best to stay out of it. Slow down.

Suggestions:

A daily sitting meditation practice.

Silence for 11 minutes a day.

Cut back on screen time.

Knit, hygee, cozy up with a blanket and stare at a fire.

Daily baths.

Anything that supports stillness.

### *Third 40-Day Practice*

*Mar 3 - Apr 12:* A creative practice that supports bringing in what you want to bring into your life. Energy follows attention. Set your attention to your intentions.

Suggestions:

This Venus retrograde transitions us into a New Era.

Creative practices including art, music, dance or anything that supports your creativity.

Goddess chants, gatherings, group meditation practices.

Say yes to friends, celebrations, and joy. But don't get married for the first time or plan something extravagant. Keep it simple and spontaneous.

Establishing these three 40-day practices will support a general movement into a time of Air-Fire that begins in the summer of 2025.

## Election

Election Day notables: **Mars opposite Pluto** 29° Cancer/Capricorn, **Mars** in pre-shadow before going retrograde; **Uranus** conjunct Algol (the winking eye of Medusa); New Moon 9° Scorpio 35'—at Justice Point; **Jupiter** stationing at 22 Gemini

Kamala Harris—Wood Dragon, Sun 28° Libra, Full Moon 28° Aries, Asc 24° Gemini, Jupiter at 24 Taurus, Mars 21° Leo.

Stationing **Jupiter** conjunct her Ascendant: This is the beginning of a new cycle and an opening of who she is in the world. This is a positive transit for her and support for her rising into a new position.

Saturn in the 10<sup>th</sup>—harvest time in career, achievements coming to full fruition after building over the past 20 years.

Rahu-Venus (Feb 2024 – Feb 2027). Rahu in 1<sup>st</sup> house—ambition for purpose; Venus rules 5 (good karma) and 12 (tapped into the suffering in the world), lives in 3 (writing and communication), aspects 9 (politics, travel, education). Natal Saturn in own sign in 9<sup>th</sup> house—good for politics—Venus sheds his light on Saturn—so Venus bhukti is good for politics. Rahu and Venus have good relationship so this is a good time for her. In Rahu-Venus we are also willing to do whatever it takes to be in relationship, to be in connection. Her passion for joy and love is real—even if she is willing to do some shady things to get there.

Donald Trump—Fire Dog, Sun 23° Gemini, Full Moon 21° Sag, Asc 29° Leo, North Node 21° Gemini

Transits on Election Day:

**stationing Jupiter** conjunct North Node and Sun in the 10<sup>th</sup> house. This is a powerful transit for catapulting him back into the White House—or at least some major career opening. This is a transit where the clouds part and a bright, shiny Jupiter bursts things open. On the flip side, Jupiter is shining light on the North Node—which can bring on a reversal of fortune. It is certainly a big day for Trump. He might lose the election and win something else—like if the market goes really well, or he wins a court case, or he rings the bell on another insurrection. There is also a chance that he is declared the winner, but actually stole the election. Jupiter promises but it doesn't always deliver. However, it does seem that the Mars-Pluto opposition, as triggering, agitating, and potentially violent as that is, I don't think it will let him get away with it. Once Pluto goes into Aquarius two weeks after the election, the truth is clear.

**Mars-Pluto opposition** lands close to his Venus and Saturn, which is difficult.

Saturn in the 7<sup>th</sup> house = blossoming, the world tells him what it wants from him. It's a negotiation. He can no longer do whatever he wants to do. His work (both good and bad) is revealed to the world.

Jupiter Dasha Donald has a good Jupiter. It is a friend to the chart and lives in the house of money, sheds its light on the houses of power, career, and health. It rules over the houses of good karma and power. Jupiter is the brightest planet and most auspicious in general. Jupiter transits are more impactful during a Jupiter Dasha—so Jupiter conjunct his Sun and North Node is very important—and generally considered positive.

Jupiter-Ketu (Oct 24, 2023 – Sep 29, 2024). Ketu is about release, clearing, disappointments, and losses. It is a time of set-backs and can also support poor mental health—unless the person is doing deep spiritual practices—then it is a good time. Probably not for Donald.

Jupiter-Venus (Sep 29, 2024 – May 31, 2027). But yikes, he changes Bhuktis so close to the election. Leaving a time of losses and entering a time of passion, love, and abundance. I think this translates to adoring fans for Donald. In his chart, Venus lives in the 12<sup>th</sup> house, the house of suffering in the world. He may be especially tuned into the suffering of others or appear to be. It could be that something happens in October that makes him a more sympathetic person or someone in need of sympathy. That the Jupiter stationing is opposite transiting Venus, may also be a boost for him.

Evaluation

Donald has good transits for winning—but what he wins is unlikely the presidency, which requires more serious transits. Kamala has the drive to win this and she is on solid footing in herself and in her ambition. When Donald changes Bhuktis, there is a wild card moment—

especially since this happens so close to an eclipse that triggers his Neptune-Chiron, which can be about deception and delusion.

General outcome: She wins. He can't process it and becomes more delusional, but also gets away with his crimes. There are violent backlashes, but they are not coordinated and peter out by mid-March. It is a rocky start to whoever moves into the White House, but by June we are in a new era. It could also be that if charges are dropped and he is no longer in danger of prison, that the Jupiter-Venus time could be him dropping out of the election. Jupiter-Venus just doesn't have the umph, the desire, the charge to get the job done. The eclipses (Sep 2 – Oct 17) could surge a new Republican candidate into the race.
